RTI Act Cell

The Right to Information Act, 2005 (22 of 2005) has been enacted by the Parliament and has come into force from 15 June 2005. All Universities and Colleges established by law made by Parliament or by State Legislature or by notification by the appropriate Government or owned, controlled or substantially financed directly or indirectly by funds provided by the Government shall come within the meaning of a Public Authority under this Act. Therefore, in accordance with the RTI objectives, KMM College of Arts and Science, Thrikkakara has also constituted the RTI Cell to enable the students, citizens and stakeholders to have necessary access to the RTI related information and disclosures. Ragging is a criminal offense and UGC has framed regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging .In pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 08/05/2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009 ,in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (g) of sub-section (1) of section 26 of the UGC Act, 1956, the UGC notified "Regulation on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions ,2009".In adherence to the above mentioned law, KMM College had constituted the anti-ragging committee in compliance with the UGC regulations. This committee is too established to prevent and to prohibit the menace of ragging of any type with in the campus.

PTA Executive Committee
