The annual process of gathering feedback involves input from students, parents, teachers and alumni. The feedback is gathered and presented to the IQAC in a summarized report with statistical insights. The quality assurance focuses heavily on feedback related to the curriculum, teaching methods and evaluation processes.

For this survey, a Google form based questionnaire was sent to students and other stakeholders using online tools. Participants rated their responses on a five-point scale, from "strongly disagree" to "strongly agree".

For a thorough analysis, the feedback responses are reviewed. The feedback report provides valuable insights for the IQAC to pinpoint areas for improvement. This report guides the implementation of measures to improve the quality of the college's academic process. In addition, the feedback helps to prepare an action taken report, which documents the measure adopted in response to the feedback.

The table shows that the mean scores of students' responses across all parameters consistently exceed 3.5, with some even reaching above 4. This suggests that students are generally satisfied with the curriculum and infrastructure provided by the institution. The highest mean score of 4.74 indicates a particularly high satisfaction level with the effectiveness of the conduct of college examinations. Considering the overall mean score of 4.05, further improvements were recommended across all parameters to raise the overall rating to 4. A rating of 4 reflects a satisfactory perception among students. The recommendations to focus on improving various aspects underscores to continually enhance the student experience and infrastructure.

The syllabus is recommended for providing up-to-date knowledge in the field, with a rating of 3.87. Regarding assessment and evaluation, there are positive ratings. Nonetheless, improvements are needed in the availability of resources and basic amenities like drinking water, washrooms and common room facilities. The overall mean feedback from teachers stands at 4.01, suggesting that improvements in areas with lower scores could further enhance the rating.
